



WHAT: 15th Annual Walk for Warmth. Walk-a-thon to raise money for the Mifflin-Juniata Energy Bank.

WHO IS HELPED BY THE WALK FOR WARMTH?

- Recipients of the Walk for Warmth funds are those who are ineligible for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) benefits but have insufficient income to meet home heating needs or are 65 years and older and struggle to meet the rising costs of living on a fixed income.
- Donations will allow Energy Bank recipients to access funds to assist with paying rent on time or paying heating costs.
- Those who come to the Energy Bank are under employed, live on a fixed income, or have recently experienced a life changing event such as illness, loss of a loved one, or divorce/separation.
